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Waiver Form

The undersigned (Participant) has enrolled for the Strasburg Rail Road (Rail Road) Yesterday & Today two-day tour for July 17 & 18, 2010 (the Tour). In consideration for the Rail Road's granting of the Participant the right to participate in the Tour, and intending to be legally bound, Participant understands and agrees as follows:

1. The Tour is of a bona fide mechanical shop where manufacturing and industrial activity is performed. By way of example and without limitation, such activity includes heavy, moving machinery, boilers at high temperature and under pressure, moving railroad equipment, tripping and floor hazards, overhead hazards, smoke, dust, dirt, boilers and pressure vessels, electrical hazards, hazardous substances, grease, chemicals, machine and inspection pits, sparks, loud noises, odors, gasses, heat, flashes and glare, and other hazards associated with heavy industry.
2. Participants understand that there will be a safety talk prior to the start of the Tour. Participant understands that s/he will have the opportunity to ask questions at the safety talk and agrees to ask any questions that Participant may have at that time to ensure a safe Tour for him/her self, all other Participants and all Rail Road employees. Participant agrees to abide by all directions and instructions given at the safety talk, and to otherwise obey and follow all instructions that may be given by Rail Road representatives during the Tour.
3. Participant agrees to wear at all times all required safety equipment.
4. The Participant understands all of the above instructions and risks of entering into a heavy manufacturing facility of the type described above, and one with the risks and hazards as noted above including all of those set forth in Paragraph 1, above. Participant hereby agrees, for him/herself and all of his/her successors and assigns to assume all risk of harm, illness or injury of whatever kind or nature that Participant may experience as a result of the Tour and to hold the Rail Road harmless for any harm, illness or injury of whatever kind or nature that occurs as a result thereof.
