ABOUT THE CAR:



The Lee E. Brenner Dining Car is the only wooden passenger dining car still in operation in the United States.

Originally built in 1909 and run on the Boston & Maine Railroad, the car was purchased by the Strasburg Rail Road in 1972. It is beautifully restored into a dining car from the golden age of railroading.

The car's namesake, Lee E. Brenner, served as president of the Strasburg Rail Road Company from 1963 to 1964.
