To Our Guests:

As our local community, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and these United States of America continue to grapple with the impact of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19), I want to share with you that **the Strasburg Rail Road will be closed to the general public now through April 5, 2020**.

Furthermore, we recognize the rapidly changing nature of this global situation, and we will continue to monitor local and national reports on the evolving impact of COVID-19. We will utilize the most current guidance from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), the World Health Organization (WHO), the Pennsylvania Department of Health, as well as additional government agencies and health care providers to help us respond wisely and appropriately.

While our doors are closed to the general public, we will continue the enhanced cleaning protocols previously enacted, including frequently disinfecting often-touched surfaces such as door handles, countertops, point of sale system surfaces and restroom surfaces.

We have asked all our Team Members (and we urge everyone) to follow the CDC guidelines to prevent the spread of the COVID-19 infection. These guidelines include:

- Wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Cover a cough or sneeze – preferably with a disposable tissue.
- Avoid touching your face – especially your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.
- Put distance between yourself and others and follow local shelter-in-place instructions.
- Stay home if you are sick, except to get medical care.

Though we are closed to the general public, our Freight Department continues its operation as a life-sustaining business. While we truly appreciate our fans, for the protection of our employees working onsite to keep needed commodities moving, we ask that you do not enter our property while we are closed. Federal, State and Local law enforcement will be patrolling our property. Individuals entering our property during this pandemic, without proper authorization, will be considered trespassers.

Over the past 188 years, our little short line has weathered many hardships, including economic turmoil, world war, pandemic, and natural disaster.
